

JULY 20, 2009

A Special Meeting of the Millwood City Council was called to order by Mayor Dan Mork at 7:00 p.m. July 20, 2009 at the Millwood City Hall. Council members present were: Mr. Brian Ellingson, Mr. Kevin Freeman, Mr. Glenn Bailey and Mr. Shaun Culler. Also present: Attorney Brian Werst, Maintenance Supervisor Cleve McCoul, Deputy Treasurer Debbie Matkin and City Planner Tom Richardson.

Valerie Putnam led the Flag Salute.

ARGONNE ROAD REBUILD PROJECT UPDATE: Mr. Matt Gillis of Welch Comer Engineers advised that the sidewalk contractor is making good progress. He said that some of the concrete intersection at Empire Ave will need to be replaced by Red Diamond when they return to the job. Councilmember Ellingson asked Mr. Gillis to look into the unsafe condition of the piles of material on the county right of way west of Argonne.


ORDINANCE #382 PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

Mayor Mork explained the changes in the proposed parking restriction ordinance. Ms. Deanne Cuevos, 8615 E Frederick, asked if the no parking restriction on Laura could be extended from Grace to Frederick, and along Frederick from Laura to Sargent. It was suggested that she contact her neighbors on Frederick to petition for the parking restrictions on that street. Mr. Freeman told Ms. Cuevos that "no parking" means no parking for everyone; the no parking restrictions would apply to residents and their visitors. Councilmember Bailey moved to approve Ordinance #382, with the amendment that the parking restriction on the east side of Laura Rd be from Frederick to Buckeye. Motion seconded by Mr. Freeman. Motion passed unanimously.

STAFF REPORT.

Mr. Richardson explained the Principles for Collaborative Planning which have been developed by the Planning Technical Advisory Committee for approval by the county and the various cities in the county. This will apply to joint planning agreements for urban growth areas in the county. Millwood does not have an urban growth area.

Mr. Freeman moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Bailey. Mayor Mork adjourned the meeting at 7:28 p.m.
