ORDINANCE #448

NOVEMBER 12, 2013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLWOOD, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 2013 SALARY SCHEDULE; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, the schedule of salaries and wages for city officers and employees has heretofore been set in the City's 2013 budget ordinance, as amended, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the schedule of salaries and wages for city officers and employees as October 1, 2013, and

WHEREAS, such amendment of the schedule of salaries and wages of city officers and employee does not require an amendment of the City's 2013 budget ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLWOOD WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of Schedule of Salaries and Wages. The schedule of salaries and wages contained in Appendix A of Ordinance 444 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, laws, and regulations, or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of said conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and five (5) days after its publication or a publication of a summary of this ordinance in the official newspaper of the City.
