

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILLWOOD, SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 3.08.070 OF THE MILLWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE, DELETING CHAPTERS 3.20, 3.24, 3.28 AND 3.32 OF THE MILLWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City of Millwood (the "City"), Spokane County, Washington is a non-charter code city, by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to chapter 35A.11 RCW, the City Council may adopt and enforce ordinances of all kinds relating to and regulating its local or municipal affairs and appropriate to the good government of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the grant of legislative authority to the City under chapters 35.59, 82.08 and 82.12 of the Revised Code of Washington ("RCW") and RCW 35A.37.010, the City has previously established funds for the segregation, budgeting, expenditure, and accounting for moneys received for special purposes as are required by general law applicable to such cities' activities; and

WHEREAS, certain of such funds have served their useful purpose and are no longer needed by the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY MILLWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment to Section 3.08.070 MMC. Section 3.08.070 MMC is hereby amended to read as follows (deleted language ~~stricken~~, added language underlined):

3.08.070 - Allocation of revenues to ~~cumulative-sewer~~general fund.

Funds collected under the provisions of this chapter which are net to the city shall be and are allocated to the ~~cumulative-sewer~~general fund of the city to be used for ~~engineering studies, acquisition of additional real estate, excavating, installation of treatment plant, the installation of new lines within the boundaries of the city and any and all other items, materials, services and supplies pertaining to and necessary to the construction of a sewage disposal system for the city as provided in Ordinance No. 56, passed by the council on January 8, 1962~~any lawful purpose.

Section 2. Deletion of Chapter 3.20 MMC. Chapter 3.20 MMC is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 3. Deletion of Chapter 3.24 MMC. Chapter 3.24 MMC is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 4. Deletion of Chapter 3.28 MMC. Chapter 3.28 MMC is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 5. Deletion of Chapter 3.32 MMC. Chapter 3.32 MMC is hereby deleted in its entirety.

Section 6. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, laws, and regulations, or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of said conflict, hereby repealed.
