**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLWOOD,
WASHINGTON, DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND
AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF SUCH PROPERTY.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to chapter 35A RCW, the Council of the City of Millwood is empowered to purchase, receive, hold and enjoy real and personal property and to control, convey, or otherwise dispose of the same for the benefit of the City of Millwood, and

WHEREAS, the City of Millwood has purchased or acquired the personal property and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, and

WHEREAS, the personal property and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" is obsolete, is of no value, and will not be used by the City of Millwood, and

WHEREAS, the personal property and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" is surplus to the needs of the City of Millwood, and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Millwood, acting by and through the Council of the City of Millwood, does hereby resolve as follows:

Surplus Property. The personal property and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" is declared surplus to the needs of the City of Millwood. The personal property and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" is obsolete and of no value. Staff for the City of Millwood is instructed to dispose of the personal property and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A".

Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, laws, and regulations, or parts thereof in conflict with this resolution are, to the extent of said conflict, hereby repealed.
