SIX YEAR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PLAN


WHEREAS, in accordance with state law the City of Millwood is required to annually prepare a Six Year Transportation Improvement Program, and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLWOOD, WASHINGTON
