

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MILLWOOD ANNEX TO THE DRAFT SPOKANE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, the City of Millwood (the "City"), Spokane County, Washington is a non-charter code city, by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to chapter 35A.11 RCW, the City Council (the "Council") may adopt and enforce resolutions of all kinds relating to and regulating its local or municipal affairs and appropriate to the good government of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Spokane Department of Emergency Management has previously developed the Spokane County Hazard Mitigation Plan ("Mitigation Plan"), which is a multijurisdictional plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) to provide guidance for hazard mitigation for Spokane County and the jurisdictions therein; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") approved the Mitigation Plan in May 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, and regulations related thereto, require the Mitigation Plan to be updated, with such update approved by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the Spokane Department of Emergency Management has been working on an update to the Mitigation Plan, which proposes to include a chapter specific to the City entitled "Chapter 7. City of Millwood Annex," a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "A" and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes it is in the best interests of the City to approve the document attached hereto as Attachment "A" and direct the Spokane Department of Emergency Management to include the same in the Mitigation Plan Update; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Millwood that:

**Section 1. Approval of Mitigation Plan Chapter 7. City of Millwood Annex:** The Council approves the proposed Mitigation Plan "Chapter 7. City of Millwood Annex" a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, and authorizes the Mayor to take such action necessary for the same to be incorporated into the Mitigation Plan Update and carry out the terms set forth therein.

**Section 2. Severability:** If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

**Section 3. Repeal:** All ordinances and resolutions, laws, and regulations, or parts thereof in conflict with this Resolution are, to the extent of said conflict, hereby repealed.

**Section 4. Effect:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the Council.
