A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILLWOOD, WASHINGTON DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF SUCH PROPERTY AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, the City of Millwood, Washington (the “City”) is a code city duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the state of Washington (the “State”); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City (the “Council”) may adopt and enforce resolutions of all kinds relating to and regulating its local or municipal affairs and appropriate to the good government of the City; and

WHEREAS, the personal property and/or equipment set forth below is obsolete, is of no value to the City of Millwood, is surplus to the needs of the City of Millwood, and will not be used by the City of Millwood, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Millwood as follows:

Section 1. Surplus Property: The personal property and/or equipment set forth below is declared surplus to the needs of the City. The personal property and/or equipment set forth below is obsolete. The Mayor, or his delegatee, is instructed to dispose of the same in a manner that is commercially reasonable, administratively feasible, cost-efficient, and in accordance with the law.
